PROCEEDINGS OF THE STATE LEVEL TECHNICAL COMMITTEE (**SLTC**)
MEETING HELD ON **23.03.2021**

The State Level Technical Committee (**SLTC**) meeting was held on 23.03.2021 at 04:30 P.M., in the APIIC Building, Autonagar, Mangalagiri, to review and finalize the Scales of Finance (**SoF**) for various crops for the year **2021-22**. The meeting was chaired by Dr. Poonam Malakondaiah, IAS, Spl. Chief Secretary to Government, Agriculture Department, Govt. of A.P.. Sri Y Madhusudhan Reddy, Spl. Secretary to Government, Marketing & Cooperation, Govt. of A.P., Sri Babu A, IAS, Commissioner for Cooperation & Registrar of Cooperative Societies, Govt. of A.P./ Person-in-charge, APCOB and representatives from the offices of SLBC, NABARD, Agriculture University, Departments of Agriculture, Horticulture, Sericulture, Fisheries, Sugars; Senior Officers from SBI, Indian Bank, Saptagiri Grameena Bank and APCOB have taken part in the meeting. The list of participants is enclosed as Annexure.

The Managing Director, APCOB/ Convener, SLTC welcomed all the participants to the meeting. The Convener, SLTC explained the steps/procedure involved in fixation of the Scales of Finance and role of SLTC in the process and requested all the members to share their views, make suggestions in moderating the Scales of Finance fixed by the DLTCs (District Level Technical Committees) of the districts.

The Scales of Finance suggested by the 13 DLTCs for the year 2021-22 were reviewed in detail for each of the irrigated and un-irrigated crops, both Khariff 2020 and Rabi 2020-21 district-wise, fixed by the DLTCs concerned. After having detailed deliberations on the costs involved in raising crops and gross value of yield etc., and the recommendations of the DLTCs, realistic scales of finance were arrived by the SLTC for the year 2021-22 as follows:



Note:

The committee further resolved as under:

1. The Fisheries Department is advised to arrive at the amount of finance to be provided to the Registered Boat owners, as Working Capital.
2. The Department of Horticulture made a request for providing working capital needs of farmers having Shade nets/poly houses (protected cultivation). Already working capital has been fixed for vegetable cultivation under shade nets for the year 2021-22 @1,54,000/-. However, Department may suggest for different/specific crops or for an increased area (2000 Sq. meters/5000 Sq. meter).
3. To encourage the diversification of crop production, advised to provide finance to the crops, which are not proposed by the DLTC, by comparing with the adjoining districts.
4. To display the approved Scales of Finance in all the Branches, Primary Agricultural Cooperative Societies (PACS) and Rythu Bharosa Kendras (RBK) in the state.
5. To request the DLTCs to inform the reasons where the Scales of finance suggested by them is too high compared to the scales fixed by the SLTC for the year 2020-21 (Srikakulam, Prakasam).
6. To request the DCCBs (DLTCs) to furnish a copy of the details of the Scales of Finance adopted by them to the APCOB.
7. To request the SLBC/Banks to make a presentation on Scale of Finance, Kisan Credit Card (KCC) & saturation through RBK Channels.

The meeting concluded with vote of thanks by the Managing Director, APCOB to all the participants for their active participation and contribution.
