**PROCEEDINGS OF THE STATE LEVEL TECHNICAL COMMITTEE MEETING**  
**HELD ON 23.01.2018**

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The State Level Technical Committee (SLTC) meeting was held on 23.01.2019 at 10:00 A.M., in the APCOB Head Office, Vijayawada, to review and finalize the Scales of Finance for various crops for the year 2019-20. The meeting was chaired by Sri A.K. Bhavani Shankar, Managing Director APCOB. The representatives from the offices of CC & RCS, SLBC, NABARD and Agriculture University, the Director of Agriculture, Horticulture, Sericulture, Fisheries, Director of Sugars, Senior Officers from SBI, Andhra Bank, Indian Bank, Saptagiri Grameena Bank, Syndicate Bank, APCOB Officers and Progressive Farmer have taken part in the meeting. The list of participants is enclosed as Annexure.

The General Manager (L&A), APCOB welcomed the Managing Director and all the participants to the meeting. The MD, APCOB explained the steps and procedure involved in fixation of the Scales of Finance & the role of SLTC in the process and requested all the members to share their valuable information, to make suggestions in moderating the Scales of Finance fixed by the DLTCs (District Level Technical Committees) of the districts.

It was also decided to introduce Scales of Finance for the crops under Zero Budget Natural Farming (ZBNF) method of cultivation. The crop-wise scales of finance for agriculture crops under ZBNF cultivation were suggested by the Dy. Director of Agriculture (ZBNF), RySS. The committee took up the review of Scales of Finance for each of the irrigated and un-irrigated crops, both Khariff 2019 and Rabi 2019-20 District-wise, fixed by the DLTCs concerned. The SLTC had detailed deliberations on the costs involved like cost of cultivation and gross value of yield etc., pertaining to all major crops and taking all the factors into consideration, recommended the Scales of Finance for the year 2019-20 as follows:
