In respect of seasonality for lending, The Committee has opined to fix up the seasonality for lending for Khariff as April to October, and in case of Rabi from

November to March.

In respect of due dates for recovery, with a view to have uniform due dates for recovery in the district to all banks, the committee has discussed and resolved that the due date for recovery for Khariff disbursements is 31st March of the succeeding year and due date for recovery for Rabi disbursements is 30th June of the succeeding year.
