**Proceedings of the District Level Technical Committee Meeting, Dt.06.01.2021**

The District level Technical Committee Meeting is held on 06.01.2020 in the premises of the Collectorate, SPSR Nellore and fixed the Scales of finance to all the crops normally grown in the district for **Khariff 2021 and Rabi 2021-22**.


The District Level Technical Committee has discussed thoroughly taking various aspects into consideration like climatic conditions, cost factors and seasonal conditions prevailed in the district and fixed scales of finance to all crops for Khariff 2021 and Rabi 2021-22. The concerned departments have explained the cost particulars of various crops in the District and basing on the particulars and also actual expenditure for each crop at ground level, the committee has fixed the Scales of finance to various crops.

In respect of seasonality for lending, The Committee has opined to fix up the seasonality for lending for Khariff as April to October, and in case of Rabi from November to March.

In respect of due dates for recovery, with a view to have uniform due dates for recovery in the district to all banks, the committee has discussed and resolved that the due date for recovery for Khariff disbursements is 31<sup>st</sup> March of the succeeding year and due date for recovery for Rabi disbursements is 30<sup>th</sup> June of the succeeding year.
