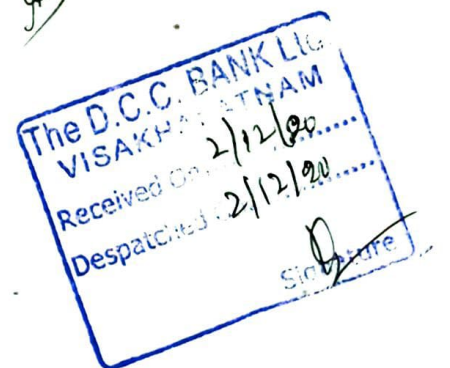
The District Level Technical Committee (DLTC) Meeting was convened on:

The Chief Executive Officer, DCC Bank welcomed the Joint Collector (RBK), DDM NABARD, LDM State Bank of India and all the participants to the District Level Technical Committee of Visakhapatnam District. He stated that the DCC Bank has been convening the DLTC meeting for fixing of Scales of Finance for various Crops for the year 2021-22 in Visakhapatnam District with all the participants.

The Chief Executive Officer, DCC Bank while welcoming the members of DLTC, Visakhapatnam emphasized the need to analyse and fix the Scales of Finance with the field level functionaries of Agriculture Department and Progressive Farmers participated in the deliberations. He requested all the members, particularly participants from Agriculture, Horticulture to deliberate and make their suggestions in fixing the scales of finances for the year 2021-22 basing on the cost of cultivation for various components involved was furnished by the Agriculture & Horticulture Department by the DLTC Committee and detailed discussions were held on finalisation and fixing of Scales of Finance for the crops growing in the District in a realistic manner.

The DD Agriculture, Visakhapatnam suggested basing the fixation of Scales of Finance taking the gross value of yield, cost of cultivation so as to ensure that the farmer is left with some surplus after repayment of bank loan for a crop.

The District Level Technical Committee took for Scales of Finance for each of the Irrigated and Un-irrigated Crops, both for Khariff 2021 and Rabi 2021-22 for the various crops. The detailed discussions on the cultivation, components involved in arriving at the cost of cultivation, yield and also value of gross yield, etc. pertaining to various crops fixed the scales of finance taking the local factors into consideration.
