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Proceedings of Sub-Committee Meeting

A meeting of SLBC Sub-committee on Expansion of Branch Network, FI & Others was held through hybrid mode i.e physical presence and VC on 22.03.2024 at 11.30AM in SLBC conference hall, Zonal office, Union Bank of India, Vijayawada. The meeting was chaired by **Shri. M. Ravindra Babu**, General Manager & Convener, SLBC AP and attended by **Shri Ch Sridhar, IAS, MD, APTIDCO (VC)**, **Shri C Hari kiran, IAS, Spl. Commissioner (Agriculture), Govt. of AP**, **Shri Dr. S. Greep**, State Director, KVIC, **Smt. M. Padmavathi**, Deputy Director Agriculture, Govt. of AP, **Shri M V S N Murthy**, CIO (IF, SLBC), Finance Department, Govt. of AP, **Shri R K Mahana**, General Manager, RBI (VC), **Shri MSR Chandra Murthy**, Dy. General Manager, NABARD, Executives and Senior officials from major Banks.

Shri M. Ravindra Babu, General Manager & Convener, SLBC AP has extended a warm welcome to all participants. He briefly explained the importance of each agenda item to the forum and urged the concerned members to diligently address the action points of this meeting. He emphasized the importance of implementing these points thoroughly to fulfil the Government's expectations.

Shri Raju Babu, Asst General Manager, Co-ordinator, SLBC AP has presented the Agenda in seriatim to the forum for discussion.

Agenda 1: Expansion of Branch Network in the State of Andhra Pradesh

Shri Raju Babu, AGM SLBC has explained the importance of expansion of Branch Network in the State of Andhra Pradesh and the deliberations made on the topic in SLBC meetings by the Spl. Chief Secretary, Finance, Govt. of Andhra Pradesh to the forum. He informed that there is not much progress in opening of branches in the State Government identified locations despite follow up from SLBC and State Government. He reviewed the respective Banks about the present status of Branch openings in State Government identified locations in ASR and P Manyam districts, DFS identified locations where population is more than 3000 and 52 unbanked villages not having bank branch or BC or IPPB Centre within a radius of 5 km. The Present Status of each location given by Banks is as follows:

Shri M V S N Murthy, CIO (IF, SLBC), Finance Department, Govt. of AP advised the Banks to open the Branches as identified by the District Collector to cater the needs of local people. If, any Bank finds it not feasible to open the branch in the identified location, the concerned Bank has to open the Branch in alternate location within the district with the approval of DCC. He advised LDMs of ASR and P. Manyam to place an agenda for modification of such locations and allot alternate location to the Bank for opening of Branch. **(Action: Concerned Banks, LDMs of ASR and P. Manyam)**

The forum discussed on the list of 52 locations suggested by DFS and various constraints faced by the Banks in establishing a Branch or BC or IPPB Centre. Status as on 22.03.2024 is attached in **Annexure-I**. SLBC while advising Banks to explore the possibility of opening branches in nearby locations and informed the member Banks that the status report received and compiled will be submitted to DFS for further guidance.

SLBC advised the concerned Banks to expedite the process and establish the branches in State Government identified locations.

Agenda 2: Conduct of Financial Literacy Camps in Tribal Areas

AGM SLBC has explained the objective of Financial Literacy Camps to the forum that, FLC is to facilitate financial inclusion through provision of two essential components i.e. Financial Literacy and Easy access to financial products. It should aim at imparting knowledge to enable financial planning, inculcate saving habits and improve the understanding of all the Financial Literacy Centres and Rural branches. Branches should prepare an annual calendar for conduct of outdoor Financial Literacy Camps at identified locations. In terms of para 2 of RBI Circular FIDD. FLC.BC. No.22/12.01.018/2016-17 dated March 02., 2017 on Financial Literacy by FLCs (Financial Literacy Centres) and rural branches-Policy review "Rural branches of Banks are required to conduct one camp per month (on the Third Friday of each month after branch hours)" He also informed that, in recently conducted 225th SLBC meeting, Special Chief Secretary, Finance, Govt. of Andhra Pradesh advised the Banks to conduct more number of FL camps in tribal villages and create awareness about the Bank products and digital frauds among the tribal folks.

(Action: All Banks)

Further, he informed that, in 70th Empowered Committee (EC) meeting on MSME, Regional Director, RBI, pointed out that during April -Dec.23 only 8 Banks viz. APGB, APGVB, Canara Bank, CGGB, Indian Bank, SBI, SGB and UBI have conducted FL camps for MSME entrepreneurs and other Banks failed to conduct or report any FL camps. He also pointed out that, certain districts such as ASR, Anakapalli, Sri Satya Sai, Annamayya, Chittoor, Guntur, Nandyal, NTR, Palnadu and P Manyam did not witness any FL camps.

SLBC advised all the Banks to conduct FL camps for MSME entrepreneurs in all districts of their presence in the upcoming months with NABARD's assistance and ensure accurate reporting to SLBC.

(Action: All Banks)

Shri R K Mahana, General Manager, AP RO, RBI advised all the Banks to report accurate data on FL camps conducted in each district to the SLBC. He also advised all Lead Banks of the districts to recruit FL counsellors, whenever vacancies arise. He further advised LDMs to submit FL camps conducted data Bank wise to SLBC and in turn, SLBC has to verify the data with Banks data and finalise before submission to RBI.

Agenda 3: Issues in Sanction of Crop loans to RoFR patta holders in Andhra Pradesh

AGM SLBC informed that, SLBC has received many complaints on non-sanction of crop loans to RoFR patta holders from customers and LDMs. When enquired with the Banks, Banks have informed that in order to consider crop loan sanctions to these patta holders, they need to submit 1B Adangal. Banks have expressed concern over unavailability of the land details in Bhoomi Web-land portal for creation of charge.

SLBC requesting the State Government to take up the integration part as early as possible so that seamless credit to RoFR patta holders will happen.

Shri C Hari Kiran, IAS, Spl. Commissioner Agriculture, Govt. of AP informed that, RoFR land details will be available in **GIRI BHOOMI PORTAL** which is maintained by Tribal welfare department and integration with *web land portal* has to be done by Revenue department, Govt. of AP. He informed that, the integration part is under process and it may complete by next quarter ending.

Agenda 4: Pradhan Mantri Janjati Adivasi Nayaya Maha Abhiyan (PM-JANMAN)- PVTGs

AGM SLBC has informed that, Hon'ble PM has launched the PM-JANMAN on Janjatiya Gaurav Divas on 15th November 2023. The Scheme is aimed at targeted development of Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups (PVTGs), who were unreached by the schemes of Ministries / Department and therefore require multi-sectoral handholding through this Mission.

The Scheme is being implemented by the Ministry of Tribal Affairs (MoTA). It has been informed by MoTA that PVTGs residing in the select 100 Districts are spread across 16 States. Andhra Pradesh is one State among the 16 States. In AP, 8 districts are identified under PM-JANMAN viz.. ASR, P.Manyam, Eluru, Nandyal, Palnadu, Prakasam, Srikakulam and Vizianagaram and these districts are to be saturated on a Mission Mode with the identified welfare schemes. Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojana (PMJDY) and KCC have been identified as some of the schemes for saturation in these PVTGs.

LDMs of those districts mapped PVTGs villages with Bank branches in all the 8 districts.

AGM SLBC advised Banks to submit district wise PMJDY and KCC data to LDM of respective district, in turn LDM has to consolidate data from all Banks and forward to SLBC for onward submission to DFS.

(Action: All Banks and LDMs)

Agenda 5: Improvement of Bank credit exposure-scheme wise in Tribal Blocks of Andhra Pradesh

AGM, SLBC informed that, Special Chief Secretary, Finance, Govt. of Andhra Pradesh in the recently conducted 225th SLBC meeting has expressed that, the average lending in all schemes in tribal blocks of the State, be it Priority Sector loans or Government Sponsored schemes was very poor and far below the district average as well as State average, and he advised the Banks to adopt strategies to improve the situation in tribal blocks.

SLBC prepared the data block wise averages in 9 districts (predominantly tribal populated districts) of the State and the details are given in enclosed annexure-II. Banks are advised to improve the credit flow in these blocks by adopting suitable strategies fit to those areas. (Action: All Banks)

Agenda 6: Advisory Note from Directorate of Vigilance, KVIC & Directorate of PMEGP, Mumbai.

AGM SLBC informed that, Directorate of PMEGP have received Advisory Note from Directorate of Vigilance, KVIC, Ministry of Micro, Small & Medium enterprises, Govt. of India vide Ir.no. VIG/17/Grievance-PMEGP/Part-III/2023-24/295 dated 19.02.2024. Vigilance department informed that number of complaints are being received regarding aberrations in the implementation of PMEGP scheme across zones. Most of the allegations are regarding PMEGP scheme guidelines being flouted by Banks & implementing agencies.

Allegations such as setting up of fraudulent units in co-ordination with the banks or forged documents, involvement of bank officials in sanction of huge loan amount to the fake units whose accounts are ultimately declared NPA, sanction of loan on the same unit by two different Banks under the scheme, sanction of Bank loans to the units that haven't fulfilled the criteria of EDP training etc. are also made indicating collaboration of Banks in the violation of scheme guidelines. In some cases, it is observed that considerable loan has been sanctioned by Banks under the scheme to multiple units that depict bank accounts with unused CC loan. After persistent follow up, Bank has refunded huge amount of MM subsidy which indicates lack of robust monitoring system by the bank as well as field offices.

Shri. Dr. S. Greep, State Director, KVIC, informed that, such instances are not observed in the State of Andhra Pradesh in implementation of the scheme. He advised all the Banks to strictly follow the PMEGP guidelines and ensure that the message reaches to field level functionaries.

(Action: All Banks)

Agenda 7: Agricultural Marketing Infrastructure (AMI) Sub- scheme of ISAM- Stoppage of Joint Inspection.

AGM SLBC informed that, Ministry of Agriculture & farmers Welfare, GOI vide their order F.No.M-11011/06/revised Operational Guidelines/2023-AMI/156 dated 19.12.2023 has advised that all joint inspections may be stopped with immediate effect i.e. 19.12.2023 and all pending inspections of the projects may be taken up by the Branch Managers of the concerned financing / disbursing bank branches from 01.01.2024.

Shri MSR Chandra Murthy, Dy. General Manager, NABARD, advised all Banks to create awareness about the revised operational guidelines of AMI scheme among the field functionaries. (Action: All Banks)

Agenda 8: Determination of Crop season for IRAC norms of Agriculture Advances

AGM SLBC informed that, SLBC AP has already informed vide Ir. No SLBC/210/230 dated.19.11.2020 to the Controlling authorities of all Banks in the State and LDMs regarding duration of crops for the purpose of NPA classification of Agricultural advances through minutes of subcommittee meeting



conducted on 16.11.2020 at APIIC, Mangalagiri. The details of Minutes are reiterated again here for ready reference, "Convener SLBC of AP informed that the 'Crop Season' is to be determined for the purpose of NPA classification of agricultural advances. (The Master circular of RBI on Prudential Norms for Income Recognition, Asset Classification and Provisioning pertains to Advances (DBR.No.BP.BC.2/21.04.048/2015-16, dated July 01,2015)). Accordingly, based on request of APCOB (SLTC, Convener), Department of Agriculture, Govt of AP has submitted crop duration for major crops grown in our state as short duration and long duration (in Annexure - III). However, many Banks requested SLBC to reiterate the guidelines on duration of crop, seasonality and applicable IRAC norms for Agricultural advances.

After thorough deliberations, the forum approved the crop durations for major crops in the state of AP as determined by Department of Agriculture, Government of Andhra Pradesh. It was also established that the Crop season for Short duration crops will uniformly be considered as 12 months, and for long duration crops it will be 18 months.

Accordingly,

- A) Short duration crops will be treated as NPA, if instalment of principal or interest thereon remains overdue for a period of two crop seasons i.e. 24 months from due date or 36 months from the date of loan.
- B) Long duration crops will be treated as NPA, if the instalment of principal or interest thereon remains overdue for a period of one crop season i.e. 18 months from the due date or 36 months from the date of loan.

Agenda 9: APY Citizen's Choice campaign for SLBCs and Amazing Achievers of APY for Bank Branches.

AGM SLBC informed that, PFRDA launched two campaigns namely "APY Citizen's Choice for SLBCs and State Coordinators" and "Amazing Achievers of APY for Bank Branches" which are currently underway from 01.01.2024 till 31.03.2024. PFRDA advised SLBC to sensitise the Member Banks to avail this opportunity to not only achieve their annual target for this financial year but also win multiple awards and gain recognition for officials at various levels including branch officials.

SLBC advised all the Banks to improve the performance in APY enrolment under the mentioned campaigns.

(Action: All Banks & LDMs)

Agenda 10: APTIDCO - PMAY (U)-Bank Linkage- reconciliation of loans sanctioned and released by the Banks- submission of data by Banks in 49 columns proforma.

AGM SLBC informed that, APTIDCO vide Lr.no.74/Bene. Conri/APTIDCO /2021-22 dt:03-01-2024 informed that, upon a scrutiny of the details of loans sanctioned by the Banks and the amounts transferred to the APTIDCO, differences to an extent of Rs.90.00Cr was observed. MEPMA, being the channelling agency for sanction of loans to the PMAY (U) beneficiaries has also uploaded the details of PMAY loans sanctioned by Banks in their website and it is not matching with the details furnished by the Bankers. In this regard MD MEPMA, requested all the participating Banks to provide necessary data in 49 columns proforma given by the department.

Further, APTIDCO vide Lr.no.64/SLBC/2024, dated 12.03.2024 informed that, as per the terms of the operational guidelines circulated by the SLBC vide Lr.no. SLBC/51/6 dated: 08.04.2021 (ref.2 clause 10) Sale deed will be executed by the Municipal commissioner as Vendor and beneficiary as Vendee and will be kept under simple mortgage with the Bank till the loan is liquidated. Accordingly, the

Mortgage is completed in respect of 30,000 houses and the houses were handed over to the beneficiaries as on date.

Shri Ch Sridhar, IAS, MD, APTIDCO, Govt. of AP informed that, with the introduction of new software at S.R.O , MOTD is not accepted for exemption of stamp duty to TIDCO houses as the same is not mentioned in the relative list. The anomaly has been brought to the notice of the Government by the APTIDCO and the Government has taken up with the concerned authorities for making necessary amendments in the software. Around 46,000 such cases are pending for registration. In this regard, he requested Banks to release IV phase and other instalments, if any not released so far. He assured the Bankers for repayment of overdue amount.

Bankers, after thorough discussions, requested MD, AP TIDCO to pay the overdue amount in TIDCO housing loans to prevent accounts from becoming NPAs. They also requested the department to conduct awareness camps for TIDCO beneficiaries about loan repayment, involving officers of Tahsildar rank and above. In response, he assured all the Banks that the overdue amount would be paid and awareness camps for beneficiaries would be organised by the department.

(Action: All Banks & APTIDCO)

The meeting was concluded with vote of thanks to the Chair and other dignitaries.

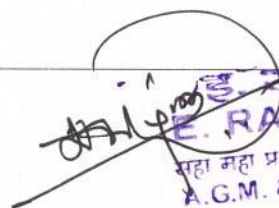
